

Christmas Lake Homeowner's Association Member:

We are getting closer to the time for this fall's boat, lift and dock removal. Here is the schedule that will be followed for boats:

September 26 – 27: Landing construction

September 28-29: Trial boat pulling 5 to 10 watercraft

October 3 – 6: Full scale boat pulling 45 – 60 watercraft

October 10 – 13: Full scale boat pulling 45 – 60 watercraft

October 16 – 18: Final boat pulling

There is an online scheduling system that has been created for you to select a time for the removal of your boat. It is located at <http://www.signupgenius.com/go/20f0d4fa4aa29a1fd0-boat>. You will see there are several hourly times for each day with three removal slots per hour. It is preferable if you have your own trailer or removal equipment to select one of the weekend days. Those that have a trailer or other removal equipment provided by a removal company should schedule times on Mondays and Fridays. Select a slot and click "Submit and Sign Up" at the bottom of the screen. You will then be requested to fill in what you are requesting to remove from the lake in the blank box on the right. Fill in your name, email address and phone number. You can enroll as member of Signup Genius to edit your entry if you need to. If you choose not to, email changes after the initial entry to Roger Norberg at rnorber@me.com or call him at **612-991-8910**. Be sure to have your removal company call Roger Norberg prior to your removal date to discuss proper removal procedures. There will be more detailed instructions during this coming week for lifts and docks.
